



In-Ground Pool Vinyl Liner Replacement

Description

In-ground pool liner replacement services for pools with torn, worn, or failed vinyl liners.

Services Include

- Field Specifications of pool as-built dimensions
- In house engineering verifying liner specifications
- Production and shipping of liner
- Freight and delivery of liner to job site
- Emptying of pool and removal of existing liner
- Preparation of pool interior surfaces (5-man hours)
- Replacement of all gaskets (gaskets included)
- Drop, position and vacuum-set new liner into place
- Start of fill water, return trip to start equipment
- Cut in of all fittings, lights, stairs, etc.

Options

Additional work may be required based on the unknown condition of the walls, floor and sub-surfaces behind existing liner.

- Owner will be notified of conditions upon liner removal and quoted the cost of repairs necessary for liner install.
- Wall and bottom repairs needed to complete the liner install that exceed the 5-man hours.
- Sub-surface conditions, such as ground water tables, which require significant water control due to water flow into the open pool structure.

Available options:

- Wall foam installation on vertical surfaces, used to cover surface corrosion and slight blemishes, available upon request.
- Custom liner top edge treatments (bead track coping) available upon request.
- Installation of bead lock to help secure liner bead into coping at difficult or damaged areas.
- Off-site disposal of trash and debris removed from vessel.
- Deck power washing removes dirt, grime, mold and mildew, which can lead to slippery surfaces.

Notes

- Owner must indicate location and placement of discharge water.
- Fill water is the sole responsibility of the owner. Poolblu will coordinate delivery if trucked in water is selected.
- Pools with wet-niche style underwater lights may incur additional charges if that the light assembly, (including cord) is
 not easily removed, due to condition of conduit or light by disconnecting the wiring connection and pulling the cord
 through the existing underground conduit.
- Pool water must be clear and bottom visible. Pools with limited visibility and excessive debris will incur additional fees.
- All pool supplies and chemicals provided on an "as needed" basis and added to your bill.
- Sealants may be used in lieu of gaskets (Based on individual market standards.)
- Domestic water (hose bib or equivalent) must be on and available to technicians at the time of service.
- Any permits, (water discharge, etc.) if required, are the responsibility of the owner.
