



## Concierge Pool Closing Service - Mesh Cover

### Description

Concierge level pool closing services for residential, in-ground pools provide pool owners an all-inclusive service for closing pools with a mesh safety cover.

### Services Include

- Drain pool to proper level for winter.
- Blow lines clear of all water.
- Remove lights from niche, attach rope and hang in pool for winter.
- Draw pool anti-freeze thru skimmer, return lines as applicable, and verify each end, (anti-freeze included).
- Blow main drain line clear of water, close valve for air lock.
- Remove deck equipment and place for storage.
- Remove plugs from circulation equipment.
- Drain and prepare all circulation system equipment for winter.
- Blow water from all circulation equipment.
- Turn off power and gas supply to equipment.
- Empty all chemical feed equipment.
- Clean filter and leave on deck for winter storage.
- Deactivate any automatic fill valves and devices.
- Vacuuming and skimming of light debris.
- Winterizing of water features, cleaners, in-floor systems, fountains, slides, sprayers, etc.
- Add winter chemical treatment to help prevent algae from forming, (chemicals sold separately).
- Install mesh safety cover per cover specifications using existing anchors.

### Options

- Missing winterizing plugs and fittings are not included in pricing and will be installed and added to final bill.
- Missing over springs and anchors not included in pricing and will be installed and added to final bill.
- Vacuuming and skimming of excessive debris in pool, due weather conditions or late season closings.
- Heater seasonal cleaning, overhaul, or tune up to eliminate any operational troubles at opening.

### Notes

- Owner responsible to have all winterizing plugs, fittings and cover onsite at time of service.
- We will notify you immediately of any unsafe conditions or system malfunctions.
- Domestic water (hose bib or equivalent) must be on and available to technicians at the time of service.
- Owner must indicate location and placement of discharge water.
- Any permits, (water discharge, etc.) if required, are the responsibility of the owner.
