



## Spa Closing Service

### Description

Complete closing services for residential spas.

### Services Include

- Remove water from spa.
- Wipe wetted (inside) surface dry and standard cleaning, light acid wash if needed.
- Blow lines clear of all water.
- Remove filter.
- Drain equipment of water and blow clear.
- Draw pool anti-freeze thru skimmers, return and air lines as applicable and verify each end. (anti-freeze included)
- Clean walls and floor.
- Clean jets, skimmer basket, pillows, and spa components.
- Clean filter compartment.
- Turn off power (and gas if applicable) supply to equipment.
- Empty and remove chemical feed equipment.
- Deactivate any automatic fill valves and devices.
- Clean, wipe down, and install spa cover.

### Options

- Cleaning of excessive build-up of scale or oils from wetted surfaces.
- Replacement of spa cover.
- Replacement of spa filters.
- Deck power washing removes dirt, grime, mold and mildew, which can lead to slippery surfaces.

### Notes

- Technicians are available 24/7/365 for emergency service through our customer care call center.
- We will notify you immediately of any unsafe conditions or system malfunctions.
- Domestic water (hose bib or equivalent) must be on and available to technicians at the time of service.
- Owner must indicate location and placement of discharge water.
- Any permits, (water discharge, etc.) if required, are the responsibility of the owner.
- Rigid thermal covers utilized for winter covers can collect snow, ice and water on top. Care must be taken to keep these covers free of excessive weight by keeping them clear.
