

# **Underwater Pool Light Replacement**

#### **Description**

Installation of replacement underwater pool light with same or similar model.

#### **Services Include**

- Turn off power to the light at junction box.
- Remove existing pool light from niche and cut cord of existing light.
- Attach pull string and pull existing light cord from junction box to light niche.
- Pull new cord through existing conduit to junction box.
- Connect new light cord to at junction box.
- Install new pool light in niche and secure.
- Turn power on to test light.
- Operate light to check connectivity.

### Add-On Options

Deck power washing - removes dirt, grime, mold and mildew, which can lead to slippery surfaces.

#### **Notes**

- Installation specifications assume that adequate unobstructed access to and from the location exists.
- Existing light, cord, and niche must be free of corrosion and light cord must pull easily through to the junction box.
- Pools that require draining below light for technician to enter the pool to install new light will incur additional fees.
- Lights, cords, niches, trim with excessive corrosion and cords lengths longer than 15 feet may incur additional Charges. Charges will be addressed onsite at time of replacement.
- Any excess time required to pull extended length cord (old out or new one in) through conduit to and from junction box will incur additional fees, underground conduit is <u>not</u> included.
- Difficulties identified beyond standard installation will be done on a time and material basis upon owner acceptance.
